We are located within Yanchep National Park. Entry fees per car load are required to enter the park and this is not included in the Treetops Adventure ticket.

HANDY TIPS



- E-Waiver forms. All participants must have a completed form. There is limited phone reception onsite, so please have your E-Waiver filled out prior to arrival.



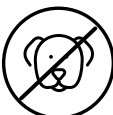
- What to Wear
 - Comfortable clothing for outdoor physical activity
 - Fully enclosed, sturdy footwear is required
 - Wet weather clothing
 - Bring along sunscreen and/or insect repellent



- Safety First. All loose items must be removed from pockets, such as keys, wallets and phones. Phones are permitted on course if safely attached with a lanyard. Phone cases with lanyards are available for purchase at Reception. Limited lockers for small personal items are available onsite.



- Stay hydrated. Please bring along a water bottle. The team can refill this for you at the Reception.



- Drinks and Snacks. We do not have drinks or snacks available, but there is an onsite café and restaurant in the National Park. We encourage BYO and ask that you help us by keeping rubbish to a minimum.
- Dogs (and other pets) are not permitted within the National Park.

SUPERVISION

Teens (13-17yrs): An adult supervising from the ground is required (1:10). Adults are welcome to purchase a ticket and climb as well.

Children (8-12yrs): An adult is required to climb as a supervisor with this age group (1:4). A ticket is required for this adult.

Juniors (3-7yrs): There is strictly no adult access on the Junior courses. An adult supervising from the ground is required (1:4). No ticket required.
