FAQs

How does Treetops Adventure ensure climber safety?

All instructors hold Working with Children Checks, and walk climbers through a Training Course before they start climbing. Our risk assessment is available on request.

How does Treetops Adventure support groups with accessibility needs?

We're committed to creating an inclusive and welcoming environment for everyone, including groups with accessibility needs. As long as participants can safely fit our harnesses and meet the weight requirements, we're happy to host them. Our courses can provide a rewarding challenge for high-functioning individuals, both physically and intellectually. Please reach out to us to discuss your group's needs so we can understand their safety requirements.

How do you manage large groups?

For **Tree Ropes Course** bookings with groups of 60 or more, we will split participants into smaller groups for harnessing and training to minimise wait times. Each smaller group will have approximately 20-30 minutes between their staggered start times to ensure a smooth transition.

For **Zipline Tour** bookings, the same guideline applies for groups of 11 or more.

Are there any age or weight requirements?

Tree Ropes Courses

- Junior Courses for ages 3-7 years
- Adult Courses for ages 8 years & above
- Maximum weight limit of 120kg

Zipline Tour

- Minimum age, 3 years & above
- Weight requirement 40-135kg

How many courses can we complete?

On average, students will complete 2-3 courses, depending on the selected difficulty level and group size attending.

What should we wear or bring?

Participants must wear fully enclosed, secure shoes like sneakers and weather-appropriate clothing for physical activity. Toss in sunscreen, insect repellent, a rain jacket and a water bottle too.

Do we need to sign a waiver?

Yes, each participant needs a signed waiver before climbing. For those under 18, a parent or guardian. For those under 18, a parent or guardian must complete the form on their behalf. A link to booking's unique waiver form will be sent to the organiser and can be shared with parents/guardians. A list of names for completed waiver forms is available on request.

What if it rains?

We operate in all weather, with rain adding an extra challenge! Please bring wet weather gear.

The park will only close for thunderstorms or high winds, and we'll notify you if that happens. If you're onsite and less than halfway through your session, we'll arrange a free reschedule. Closure is at Treetops Adventure's discretion.

What facilities are available onsite?

Toilets are inside reception. Our paths are the natural forest floor and can be uneven at time, but are generally accessible for most prams and wheelchairs.

Do you offer food and drinks?

We have a small range of hot drinks and kiosk snacks available for purchase. We encourage groups to bring along a packed lunch with minimal rubbish.

How to get to the park?

We're only 20 minutes from Launceston, located within the Hollybank Forest Reserve. If you're coming from Launceston, turn right at Goullees Road, followed by an immediate left turn into the Reserve. See map [here](#).

Payment terms & cancellation policy:

A non refundable deposit equivalent to 20% of the total value of your booking is required at time of booking. The final numbers and balance of your booking is due 7 days prior to your scheduled session date. Additional guests are subject to availability. 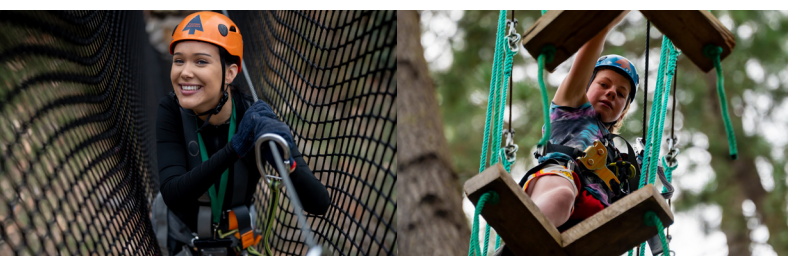
